The list may change as needs are identified by amending the budget with the Illinois State Board of Education and they will have final approval. The funds must be expended by June 2024.

The focus of the funds will be directed at addressing the learning gaps experienced from the periodic requirements for quarantining directed by IDPH/ISBE/ACHD for our students. Our district led by our Board of Education and through the efforts of our teachers and staff maintained in-person learning for almost the entirety of the pandemic. We will also use the funding to repair and improve school facilities to reduce the risk of virus transmission and exposure to environmental health hazards (improving indoor air quality/flow, heating and cooling to improve the learning environment, equipment and furniture to allow for great social distancing, and other upgrades). It will also allow support for the social and emotional learning of our students.
