5. Administrative and Committee Reports

5.1 Principal Reports

Mrs. Sheffler shared that the elementary school has enjoyed a couple of morning assemblies, the first being recognizing the 8th grade volleyball team as before their state game. Then they were entertained by bagpipe playing to start off their day. PreK screening will begin next month. We are currently looking at the potential of 50 kindergarten students for next year. Through a grant we are able to provide tutoring for some at-risk students and we are serving approximately 20 students.

- 5.2 Business Manager Report
 - We are 67% through the year and have expended 48% of our revenue which we have received 88% at this time. We anticipate some major expenditures for the door and window projects we are doing.
- 5.3 Curriculum, Assessment and Technology Director

 We are preparing for IAR state testing. We also have the SAT testing on April 8 and PSAT April 17-19.
- 5.4 Superintendent Report

We currently have 5 individuals taking the bus drivers coursework. Hopefully we will be able to have a more substantial sub driver list after they have completed the work and become licensed. Supt. Riddle recently hosted the 2 Rivers Legislative Roundtable which included Sen. Tracy, Sen. Anderson's Chief of Staff, Rep. Hammond, and Rep. Davidsmeyer. We discussed some of the issues facing educators and public education currently. It ranged from Tier II employees and their longevity in education (age 67), maternity leave disproportionately affecting female employees' ability to advance career, unfunded mandates (like required recess and 45 minute prep time proposal), ISBE Data system (IWAS), the value of the Teacher Vacancy grant (and the ambiguity of eligibility), daycare, and transportation funding. It was a very productive and enlightening discussion.

Supt. Riddle is currently working with the Calendar committee on next year's school calendar. We will have a proposal for the board in April.

They had some leaking by the football and baseball field again. We are currently working on fixing the issue. We also have a dead tree at the elementary that we will be taking down as it is a danger to students and staff.

We have started our tutoring/after school program for at risk students this month. We have approximately 20 staff that are working with students either one-on-one or in small groups. Our hope is to help remediate those students that have fallen behind. We will be having summer school for both elementary and MS/HS students in June as well as the Jump Start program for elementary students before next school year. We are going to incorporate Enrichment/Gifted programming in our summer school offerings. We are pleased we have finally gotten the approval for the fire rated gym doors that we are looking to install. These are being ordered this week. We also have a quote on updating the windows at the high school and middle school. We will be doing those in phases.
