Financial Items

- Approved bills and activity fund reports.
- Heard preliminary estimates of an increase in 2014 EAV for the district of between 5% and 6% for the
 district.

Informational Items

- Reviewed timeline for School Board elections. The window is open for people to pick up petitions. Five
 Board members have terms expire. This year the process has changed and those interested in running
 should contact the Adams County Clerk's office. Filings must be made with the Adams County Clerk
 between 12/15/2014 and 12/22/2014.
- Reviewed data on progress toward Board Goals. Heard report that students earning college credit
 while still in high school is on the rise. The two main factors are the partnership with John Wood
 Community College, and increased computer access through the 1:1 program. In 2012-13 UHS
 students earned 18 college credit hours. During the 2013-14 year, UHS students earned 48 college
 credit hours. Students are on pace to earn 38 college credits in the first semester of 2014-15.
- Finance Committee acknowledged the value of making significant upgrades to the financial software
 for the district. However, they recommend the district does not upgrade the software at this time due
 to the financial climate of the state and district.
- Building Committee reported on facility review. They will meet and prioritize work that needs to be done prior to the next meeting.
- Reported on numbers of students who have participated in certain elective courses at Unity High School over the past three years.

Action Items

- Approved closing of Greenfield Elementary at the end of 2014-15 school year. The current plan is to open the 2015-16 school year with 4th grade students attending Unity Middle School, and 2nd and 3rd grade students attending Mendon Elementary. There will be only two sections of Kindergarten and first grade.
- Approved Senior Class Trip to Gatlinburg and Pigeon Forge.
- Approved Jenny Gronewold as 7th Grade Girls' Volleyball Coach.
- Accepted Donna Davis' resignation effective at the start of 2015-16 school year.
